³**If you are admitted to a program of study beginning in summer, regulations require that you enroll full-time in the summer.** Full-time summer expenses are figured by adding \$1,300 (books and supplies), \$300 (fees), and the amount of your tuition which is: (i) for graduates 5 times the summer per credit cost; and (ii) for undergraduates 12 times the summer per credit cost. ⁴If you will be **accompanied by dependents** {spouse and/or child(ren)}, you will be fully responsible for their support and additional funds are required.
